SCOPE OF THE COLLABORATION

TERMS AND TERMINATION OF THE MoU:

2. This MoU may be terminated by mutual consent of the parties before the aforesaid term of 3 years.
3. This MoU can also be terminated by either of the parties by giving advance notice of three (3) months period without jeopardizing the ongoing collaborative undertakings.
4. The implementation and/or continuance of programmes or project established pursuant to this MoU prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of this MoU.
5. This MOU is not intended to, and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents.
6. Nothing in this MOU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other resources in support of projects or activities between the parties unless expressly stated in this agreement.
7. Upon termination of this Agreement, Institute shall cease to conduct the Training Programs; however batches which have commenced during the notice period if any shall continue, without causing any inconvenience to Trainees, which shall be governed by the terms and conditions of this Agreement.


